Please read the following carefully:

1. This declaration covers this donation and any future donation you may make to Plateau Perspectives Scotland, but please notify Plateau Perspectives Scotland if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.
2. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying Plateau Perspectives Scotland – it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of the cancellation or such later date as you specify.
3. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6 April one year to 5 April the next) that is at least equal to the tax that Plateau Perspectives Scotland reclaims on your donations in the appropriate tax year.
4. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax Plateau Perspectives Scotland reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 2).
4. Plateau Perspectives Scotland will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give. The Government will pay to Plateau Perspectives Scotland an additional 3p on every £1 you have given between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the charity does not affect your personal tax position.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, please ask your local tax office for leaflet IR65 Gift Aid.
